The VA Boston Healthcare System (BHS) is searching for the position of Chief, Medical Service. The Medical Service at BHS is closely affiliated with the Departments of Medicine at Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH) and Boston Medical Center (BMC). Annually, more than 200 interns and residents from BMC, BWH, and the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center (BIDMC) and 80 medical students from Harvard Medical School (HMS) and Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM) rotate through the BHS Medical Service. Students, residents, and fellows from all sites are taught by VA faculty of both medical schools, including 68 full-time and 16 part-time physicians. The Medical Service comprises a full spectrum of specialties, including sections of internal medicine, cardiology, gastroenterology, pulmonary, renal, infectious disease, rheumatology, endocrinology, hospital medicine, and women's health. Basic, translational, and clinical research programs on Medical Service are funded by NIH, the VA, private foundations, and industry.

BHS is the main tertiary care referral center for all of New England. BHS comprises three main campuses: Jamaica Plain, West Roxbury, and Brockton, and six outpatient clinics in the greater Boston area and central Massachusetts. BHS has a total capacity of 647 acute, chronic and residential beds, treats a population of 65,000 veterans, and hosts over 600,000 outpatient visits. BHS is strongly affiliated with Harvard Medical School (HMS), Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM), and multiple HMS- and BUSM-affiliated hospitals.

We seek a distinguished physician-scientist or teacher-clinician with a strong academic background and national stature. Academic and clinical qualifications must be appropriate for appointment at the level of Associate Professor or Professor of Medicine at HMS, full-time. Applicants must have sufficient clinical and administrative skills to lead the clinical and academic programs of the Medical Service. The successful candidate will also serve as Vice Chairman of Medicine at BWH.
