The Department of Ambulatory Care and Prevention (DACP), a joint academic department of Harvard Medical School and Harvard Pilgrim Health Care (HPHC), is seeking a faculty member in pharmaceutical policy and health services research at the rank of Instructor, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor.

The faculty member will play a major role in the Drug Policy Research Group, a WHO Collaborating Center in Pharmaceutical Policy that conducts research on pharmaceutical policy, cost containment, access to medicines, insurance coverage, and quality of medication prescribing. This work has had substantial impacts on state, federal, and international health policies. He or she will conduct independent and collaborative research aimed at improving health care delivery, health policy, and population health. He or she will also participate in teaching at Harvard Medical School or advising fellows and graduate students in the Harvard University PhD program in Health Policy.

The Department is uniquely positioned as a research and teaching group with joint support from Harvard Medical School and HPHC, a large non-profit health plan. It has a multi-disciplinary and collaborative faculty of approximately 35, including health services researchers, social scientists, epidemiologists, internists, pediatricians, and biostatisticians.

Ideal candidates for this position have a PhD in health policy, health services research, economics, a related field, or an MD with similar experience, a record of peer-reviewed publications, and experience and interest in one or more of the following:

- Health and Pharmaceutical policy and behavior change
- Population health
- Process and performance improvement
- Quality and cost-effectiveness of care
- Preventive health services
- Chronic disease management
- Health disparities

The Department offers a supportive and collaborative environment.
