

## **FACULTY POSITION IN HEMATOLOGY**

The Division of Hematology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, an affiliate of Harvard Medical School, seeks applicants for appointment at the level of **ASSISTANT or ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR** in the areas of benign hematology and/or hematologic malignancies. Areas of emphasis may include, but are not limited to, sickle cell disease, thrombosis and hemostasis, oncogene and tumor suppressor gene function; signal transduction; cell non-autonomous contributions to cancer phenotypes; cell adhesion, migration, and metastasis; angiogenesis; and hematopoietic stem cells. Successful applicants will be expected to maintain a strong, well-funded research program. Clinician scientists will have a clinical appointment at Brigham and Women's Hospital and will provide patient care and teaching services.

Applicants should include curriculum vitae, brief summaries of past accomplishments, and future research plans. Letters of recommendation should be sent separately from three scientists who can provide an evaluation of the candidate's accomplishments and future potential for both research and teaching.
