The Department of Ambulatory Care and Prevention (DACP) seeks a full-time faculty member in health policy research. S/he will lead independent research aimed at improving population health and health care delivery. In addition, the faculty member will be expected to contribute expertise in economic evaluation to collaborative, grant-funded research projects led by other investigators in the department.

DACP is a research and teaching group with joint support from a medical school and a large, non-profit health plan. It has a multi-disciplinary faculty of approximately 35, including health services researchers, social scientists, epidemiologists, internists, pediatricians, and biostatisticians.

Ideal candidates for this position have a PhD in health policy, economics, or a related field, a record of peer-reviewed publications, and experience and interest in one or more of the following:

- Population health
- Health policy
- Process and performance improvement
- Quality and cost-effectiveness of care
- Preventive health services
- Chronic disease management
- Health disparities
- Health information technology
