The Clinical Research Program (CRP) at Children's Hospital Boston and Harvard Medical School seeks a PhD biostatistician at the level of Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor with collaborative surgical research support from the Department of Urology and other hospital research programs. The successful candidate will be expected to provide statistical support for all aspects of investigation including the design and analysis of clinical trials. He or she will collaborate on research with clinical and basic science investigators, contribute to grant applications, participate in teaching biostatistics to clinical faculty, and mentor fellows and junior faculty.

The CRP currently supports several ongoing observational studies and clinical trials from various departments in the Hospital. Current research areas of emphasis in the Department of Urology include but are not limited to the diagnosis and treatment of prenatal and postnatal urologic and renal abnormalities, the evaluation of robotic assisted laparoscopic surgery, tissue engineering and the use of autologous tissues to reconstruct the urinary tract, and stem cell research to recreate organs.

Candidates should have a strong record of collaborative research, demonstrated ability in the design and analysis of randomized controlled clinical trials and longitudinal studies, and excellent written and interpersonal skills. A PhD in biostatistics or statistics is required. Faculty appointments will be in the Department of Surgery at the Harvard Medical School. Rank will be commensurate with experience.
