### **PSYCHIATRIC INVESTIGATORS IN NEUROIMAGING RESEARCH**

Post-Doctoral / Faculty research opportunities are available in a dynamic new neuroimaging research initiative studying individuals in early phases of psychotic disorders or at risk for these disorders. Applicants should have an M.D., Ph.D., or equivalent degree, with at least one year of specialized post-doctoral experience in functional or structural neuroimaging, magnetic resonance spectroscopy (MRS), and/or diffusion tensor imaging, as applied to major psychiatric illnesses. Prior research experience and interest in MRS would be highly desirable. Additional qualifications include experience in research design and methodology, statistics, and quantitative data analysis. (Familiarity with one or more commonly used environments such as Matlab, SPM, IDL, FSL, etc. would be desirable.)

In addition to contributing to the Department's expanding research initiatives, the appointee will be expected to play a significant role in our academic and training programs, including the Harvard Longwood Psychiatry Residency Training Program. Appointment at the rank of Instructor/Assistant level at Harvard Medical School will be determined by experience, training and achievement. Departmental start-up funds commensurate with experience and scope will be available to assist with development of externally funded research.
